## **PERNYATAAN BERSAMA**

**Antara Kementerian Kelautan dan Perikanan Republik Indonesia dan  
Departemen Pertanian, Perikanan dan Kehutanan Australia**

Jakarta, 31 Juli 2025 – Kementerian Kelautan dan Perikanan Republik Indonesia (KKP Indonesia) dan Departemen Pertanian, Perikanan dan Kehutanan Australia (DAFF Australia) menyatakan komitmen hubungan bilateral dan melanjutkan kegiatan bersama dalam bidang perikanan mencakup pemahaman dan sosialisasi informasi produksi dan standar ikan dan produk perikanan.

Dua badan ini merupakan otoritas yang berwenang untuk jaminan keamanan pangan-asal ikan yang berkomitmen untuk berkolaborasi untuk kepatuhan terhadap standar ketahanan pangan global guna kepentingan perdagangan dan kesehatan kedua negara.

Badan Pengendalian dan Pengawasan Mutu Hasil Kelautan dan Perikanan (BPPMHKP) dan DAFF Australia mengakui memiliki hubungan sejarah panjang dalam sektor perikanan semenjak tahun 2012, diinisiasi oleh kegiatan inspeksi bersama manajemen biosekuritas, kunjungan pengenalan udang ke Indonesia (2018) dan serangkaian dialog bilateral yang dilaksanakan di Australia (27 November 2022) dan di Indonesia (28 November 2022). Kedua badan sepakat untuk melanjutkan pembentukan kolaborasi mutualis sebagaimana disepakati pada pertemuan di Jakarta, pada tanggal 3 Juli 2025. Pertemuan dihadiri oleh Kepala Badan PPMHKP-KKP dan Deputi Sekretaris Biosekuriti, Operasional dan Kepatuhan, DAFF Australia.

Melalui pertemuan ini, KKP dan DAFF Australia sepakat untuk terus bermitra untuk kepentingan rakyat di kedua negara.

## **JOINT STATEMENT**

**By Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of the Republic of Indonesia and  
Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Australia**

Jakarta, 31 July 2025 – Today the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of the Republic of Indonesia (MMAF Indonesia) and the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry Australia (DAFF Australia) announced their commitment to the bilateral relationship and to continuing to work together on fisheries matters including understanding and sharing information on the production and standards for fish and fish products.

The two agencies are the competent authorities of fish-originated food safety assurance committed to collaborating toward the compliance of the global food safety standards for trade and public health interests of both countries.

Marine and Fisheries Quality Assurance Agency (MFQAA) and DAFF Australia recognize having a long history of relationship in the fishery sector since 2012, as initiated by joint inspection in biosecurity management, prawn familiarisation visits to Indonesia (2018) and series of bilateral dialogues conducted in Australia (27 November 2022) and Indonesia (28 November 2022). Both agencies also agreed to continue shaping the mutual collaboration as concurred in the recent meeting in Jakarta, 3 July 2025 attended by the Head of MFQAA, MMAF, and the Deputy Secretary of Biosecurity, Operations, and Compliance, DAFF Australia.

By today's meeting, MMAF and DAFF Australia continue to partner for the benefit of the people of our two countries.
