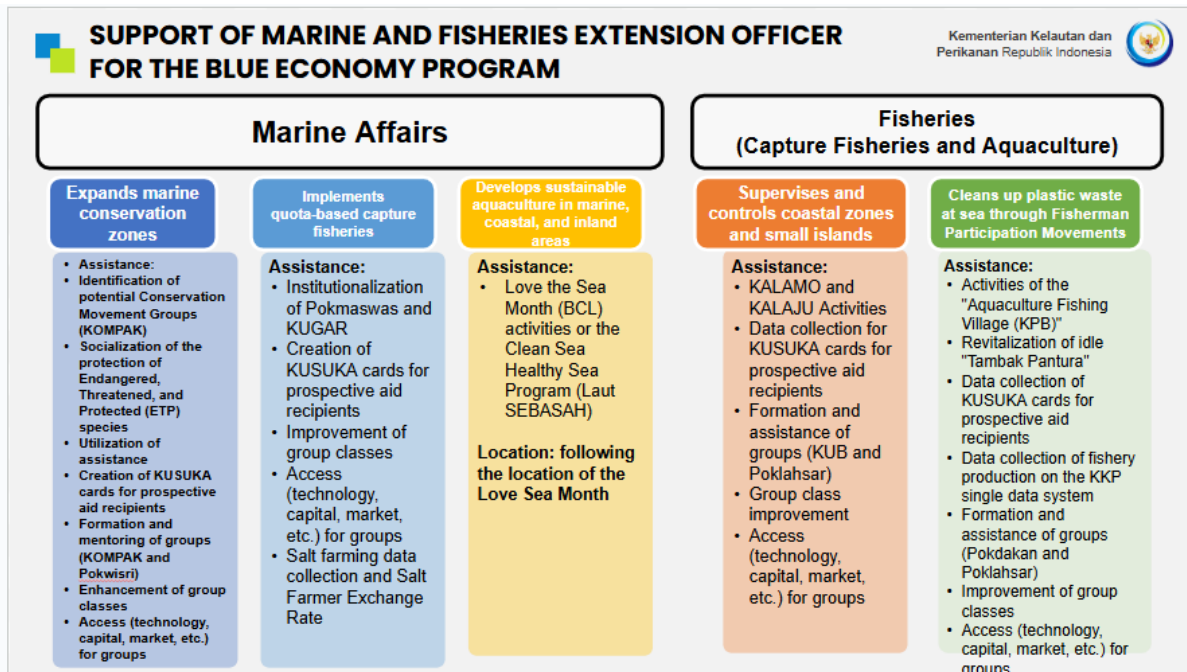

ORGANIZATION OF INSTITUTE FOR MARICULTURE RESEARCH AND FISHERIES EXTENSION

Regulation of the Minister of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of the Republic of Indonesia No. 70/PERMEN-KP/2020 on the Organization and Work Procedure of the Research and Development Center for Marine Aquaculture and Fisheries Extension

The Research and Development Center for Marine Aquaculture and Fisheries Extension (BBRBLPP) is a Technical Implementation Unit (Eselon IIb) under the coordination of the Center for Marine and Fisheries Extension with the main tasks of conducting marine aquaculture research and fisheries extension activities.

1. Preparation, monitoring, and evaluation of plans, programs, budgets, and fisheries extension reports
2. Monitoring and evaluation of extension activities, including; Extension Reports, Performance Targets (SKP), Extension activities, KKP e-Presence / attendance, Staff discipline.
3. Promotion of innovative extension programs
4. Publication of extension materials and activities

Working Areas of BBRBLPP:

- 4 Provinces, 53 districts/cities : 409 personnel in total
- Bali Province : 72 personnel (9 district/cities)
 - West Nusa Tenggara Province : 138 personnel (10 districts/cities)
 - East Nusa Tenggara Province : 131 personnel (22 districts/cities)
 - Central Kalimantan Province : 68 personnel (12 districts/cities)

Institutionalization of Business Actor Groups and Supporting Actor Groups in the Marine Affairs and Fisheries Sector

Based on the Minister of Marine Affairs and Fisheries Regulation No. 28 of 2024 on the Development and Strengthening of Business Actor and Supporting Actor Institutions in the Marine Affairs and Fisheries Sector

Business Actors in the Marine Affairs and Fisheries Sector consist of:

Cooperative Business Group or *Kelompok Usaha Bersama* hereinafter referred to as **KUB**, are non-legal entity business groups formed by fishers based on mutual agreement/deliberation and driven by a shared desire to engage in joint business activities and to be collectively responsible in order to improve the productivity and effectiveness of their members' businesses.

Marketed and Processed Fish Group or *Kelompok Pengolah dan Pemasar Ikan (Poklahsar)*, these are groups engaged in joint economic activities in processing and/or marketing of fishery products within a group setting.

Maricultured Fish Group or *Kelompok Pembudi Daya Ikan* hereinafter referred to as **Pokdakan** are groups of fish farmers formed based on mutual agreement/deliberation of all members and driven by a shared intention to engage in joint business activities and to be collectively responsible to improve their group's welfare.

Public Salt Business Group or *Kelompok Usaha Garam Rakyat* hereinafter referred to as **Kugar** are groups of organized small-scale salt producers, operating in salt ponds (community salt farmers), either by boiling seawater or by processing seawater into salt using household-scale methods.

Marine Tourism Manager Group or *Kelompok Pengelola Wisata Bahari* hereinafter referred to as **Pokwisri** are community-based groups engaged in the management of marine and fisheries services through sustainable marine tourism activities.



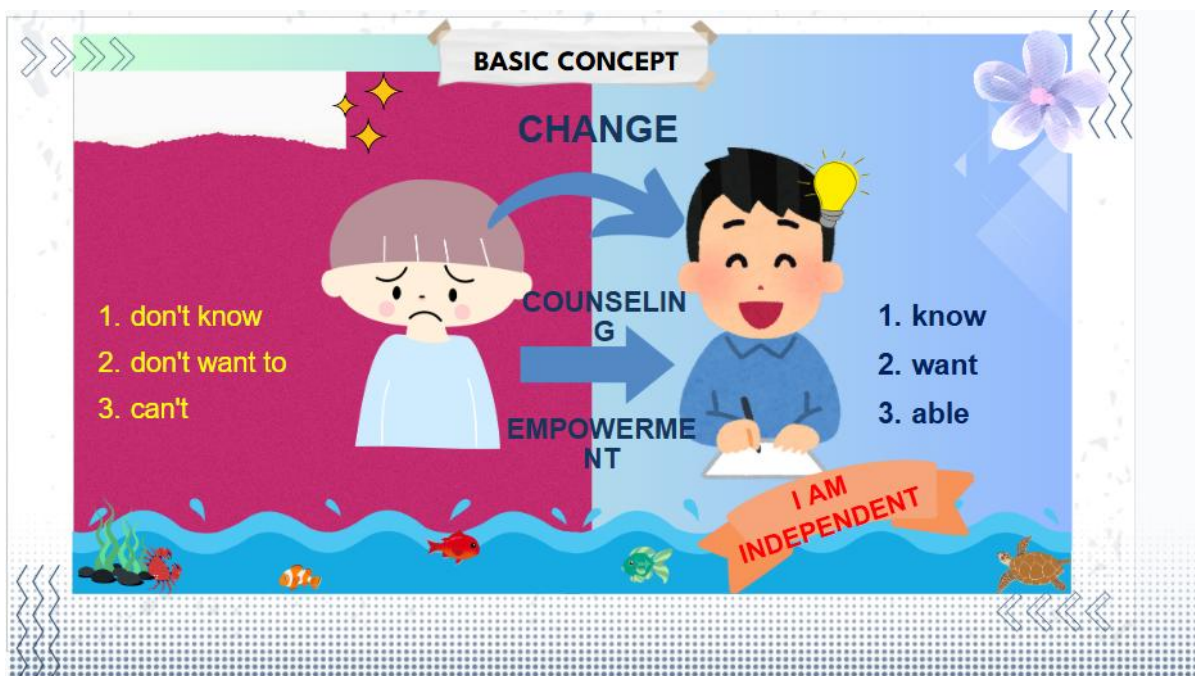

Business Actors in the Marine Affairs and Fisheries Sector, consisting of (Continued)

Public Salt Business Group (**Kelompok Usaha Garam Rakyat**), hereinafter referred to as **Kugar**, is a collection of organized producers of people's salt production conducted in salt pond areas (people's salt farmers), through boiling (producers of salt through boiling) or by processing seawater into salt (household-scale salt producers).

Marine Tourism Manager Group (**Kelompok Pengelola Wisata Bahari**), hereinafter referred to as **Pokwisri**, is a community group that manages marine and fishery services through sustainable marine tourism activities.
